rebuilt in sandstone, and substantial construction efforts in the 18th century, Bern's old city has retained its medieval character. 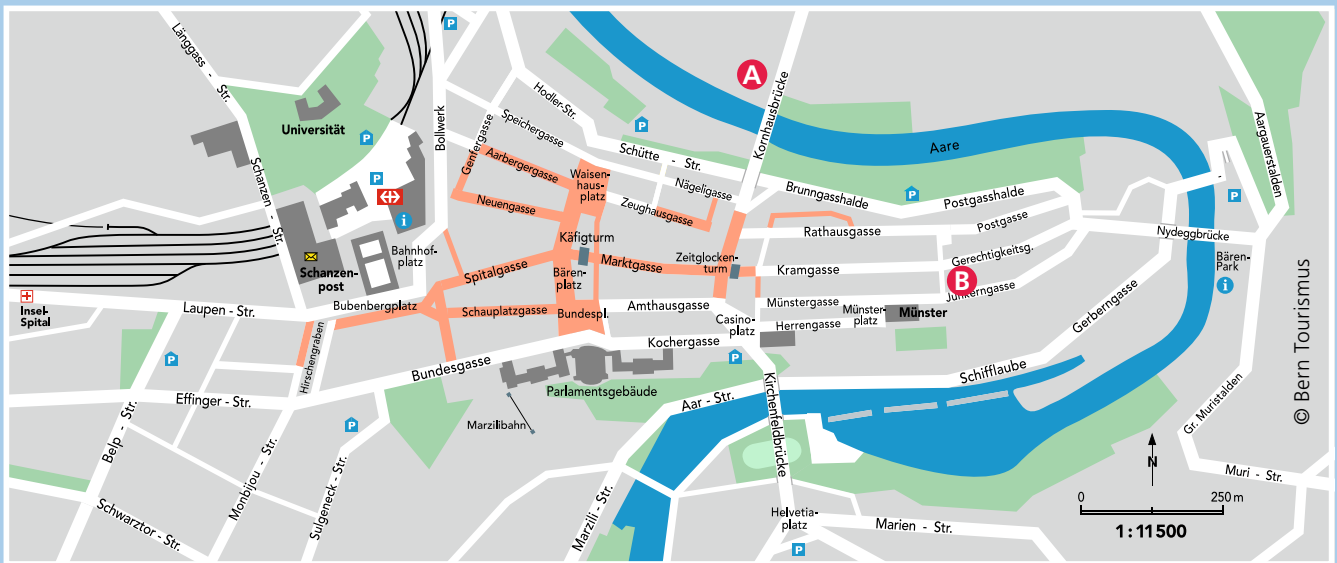
